POPULATION PRIORITIES

The highest targeted priority populations for services funded by the Lake County ADAMHS Board are

- severely mentally disabled adults/adults with severe and persistent mental illness
- severely emotionally disturbed children/adolescents
- persons who are at risk of, or are currently receiving local or state inpatient psychiatric care
- adults/youth experiencing substance use/abuse issues (including but not limited to opiates)
- mentally ill and/or chemically dependent adults/youth
- mentally ill and/or chemically dependent individuals who are homeless or at risk of homelessness
- adults and youth who are involved with the adult/juvenile criminal justice systems/re-entry
- pregnant women and/or women with children who are directly impacted by substance use, domestic violence, and other abusing issues such as sexual/physical abuse
- Parents with substance use disorders with dependent children
- individuals who are in immediate crisis/emergency situations
- other special populations as defined by the Lake County ADAMHS Board

All restricted funding/revenue source requirements will be met and used In order to serve the specific targeted priority populations as defined by the state.
